- B. Acct. #73796 Request to waive \$200.00 Compliance Fine On a motion duly made by James Lawrence, seconded by Helen Hardin, and carried by a vote of 3-1 with Chris Home voting against, the request to waive the \$200.00 was granted.
- C. Board Member Term Limits On a motion duly made by James Lawrence, seconded by Chris Horne, and denied by a vote of 4-1 with James Lawrence voting in favor, the motion to limit the number of terms a Board member can have on the Board does not carry.
- D. Survey Requirement for Expenditures On a motion duly made by James Lawrence, seconded by Chris Horne, and denied by a vote of 4-1 with James Lawrence voting in favor, surveys will not be required for expenditures. Charlie Fiser provided a vote by proxy.
- E. Proposals for Blind Replacement in Clubhouse Tabled for more information.
- F. Attorney Attendance at Monthly Board Meetings On a motion duly made by Andrew IgI, seconded by Helen Hardin, and carried by a vote of 4-1 with Sames Lawrence voting against association counsel will attend

- monthly Board meetings rather than the previously decided quarterly meetings. Charlie Fiser provided a vote by proxy.
- G. Chris Horne Resignation from Board of Directors The Board acknowledged the resignation effective after the May Board meeting.
- H. Board Vacancy Candidate Applications The Board reviewed the applications. Two applicants have expressed interest in serving the vacancy. On a motion duly made by James Lawrence, seconded by Chris Horne, and denied by a vote of 3-1 with James Lawrence voting in favor the Board will not wait until the annual meeting for the Board vacancy to be filled. On a motion duly made by James Lawrence, seconded by Chris Horne, and not carried as the vote was 2-2 with Helen Hardin and Andrew IgI voting against extending the deadline for Board member vacancy applications. On a motion duly made by Andrew IgI and seconded by Chris Horne, the motion to appoint a board member after the original deadline of April 15th carried by a vote of 3-1 with James Lawrence voting against.
- Clubhouse Rental Inspection Contract Ending The Board discussed. The janitorial company will move services to Monday mornings to ensure that cleaning after the weekend with rentals is completed.
- X. EXECUTIVE SESSION The Board convened into Executive Session to discuss legal matters. Upon conclusion of the session, the Board voted on the following items.
