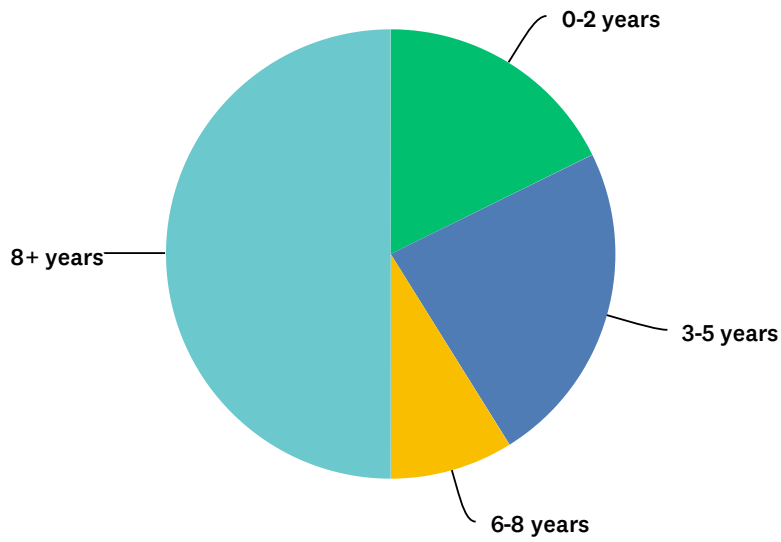


# Q1 How long have you lived in the neighborhood?

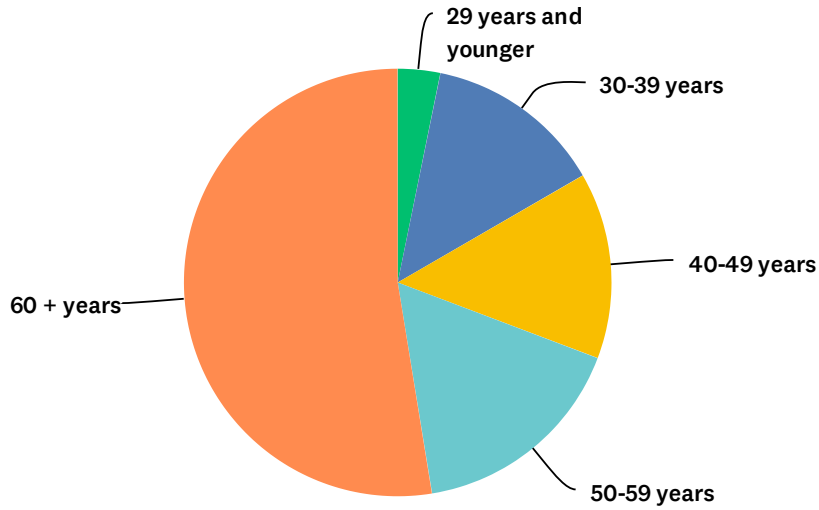

## Q2 What is your age group?

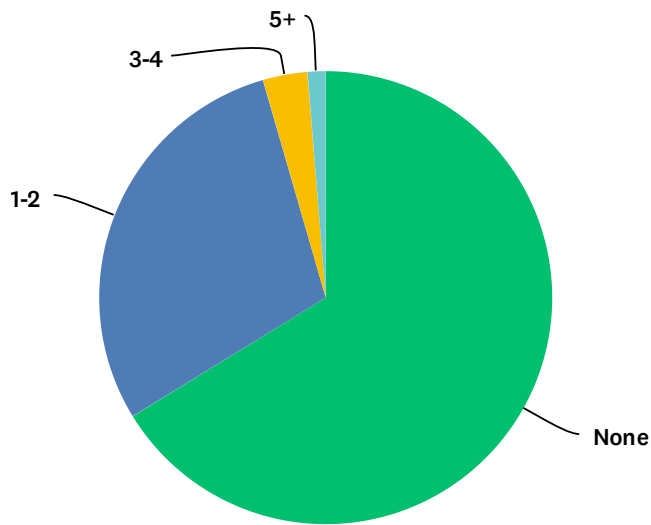

### Q3 How many children live in your home?

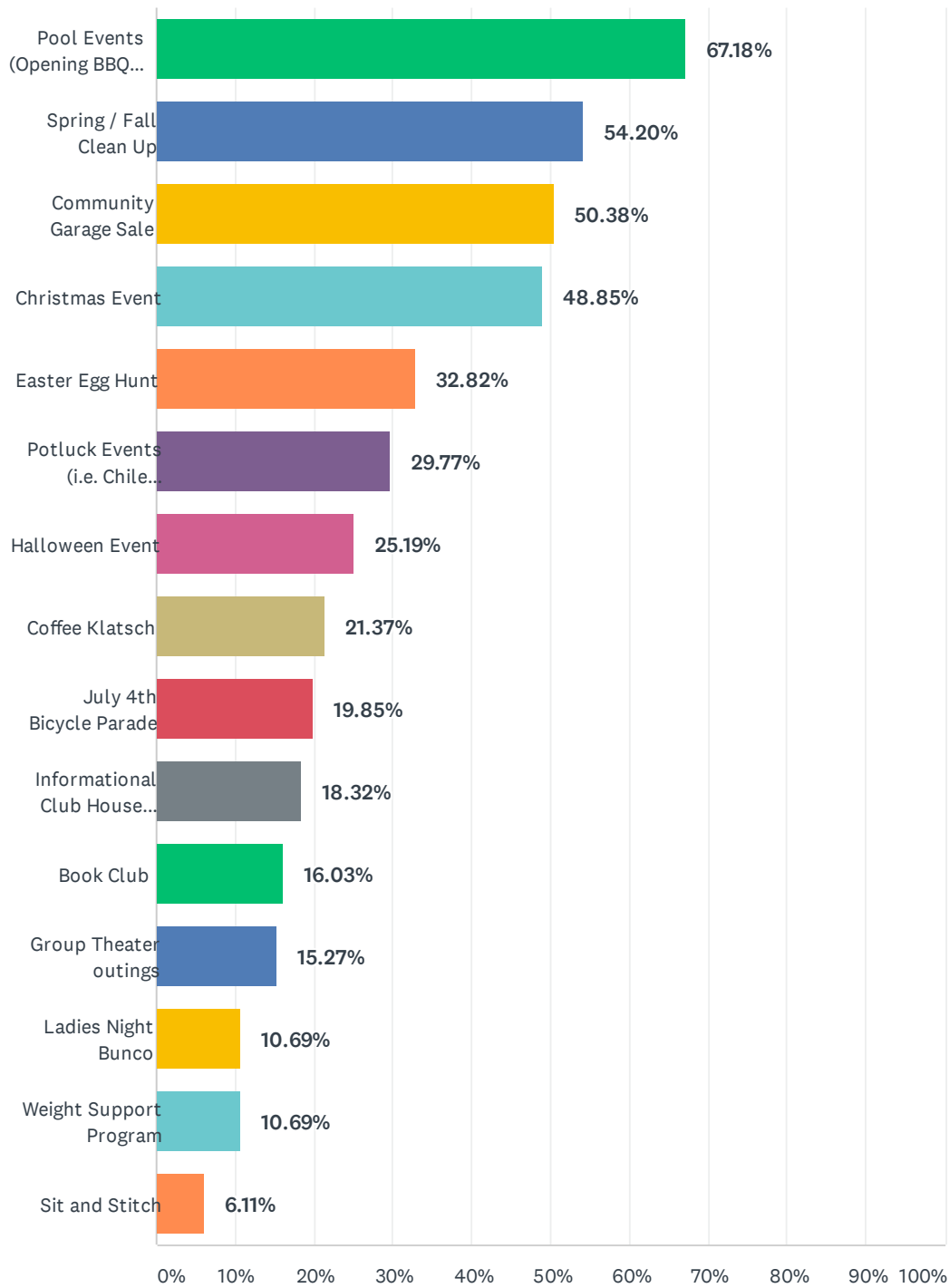

### Q4 Which HOA sponsored events has a member of your household attended in the past? Please check all that apply and click OK.

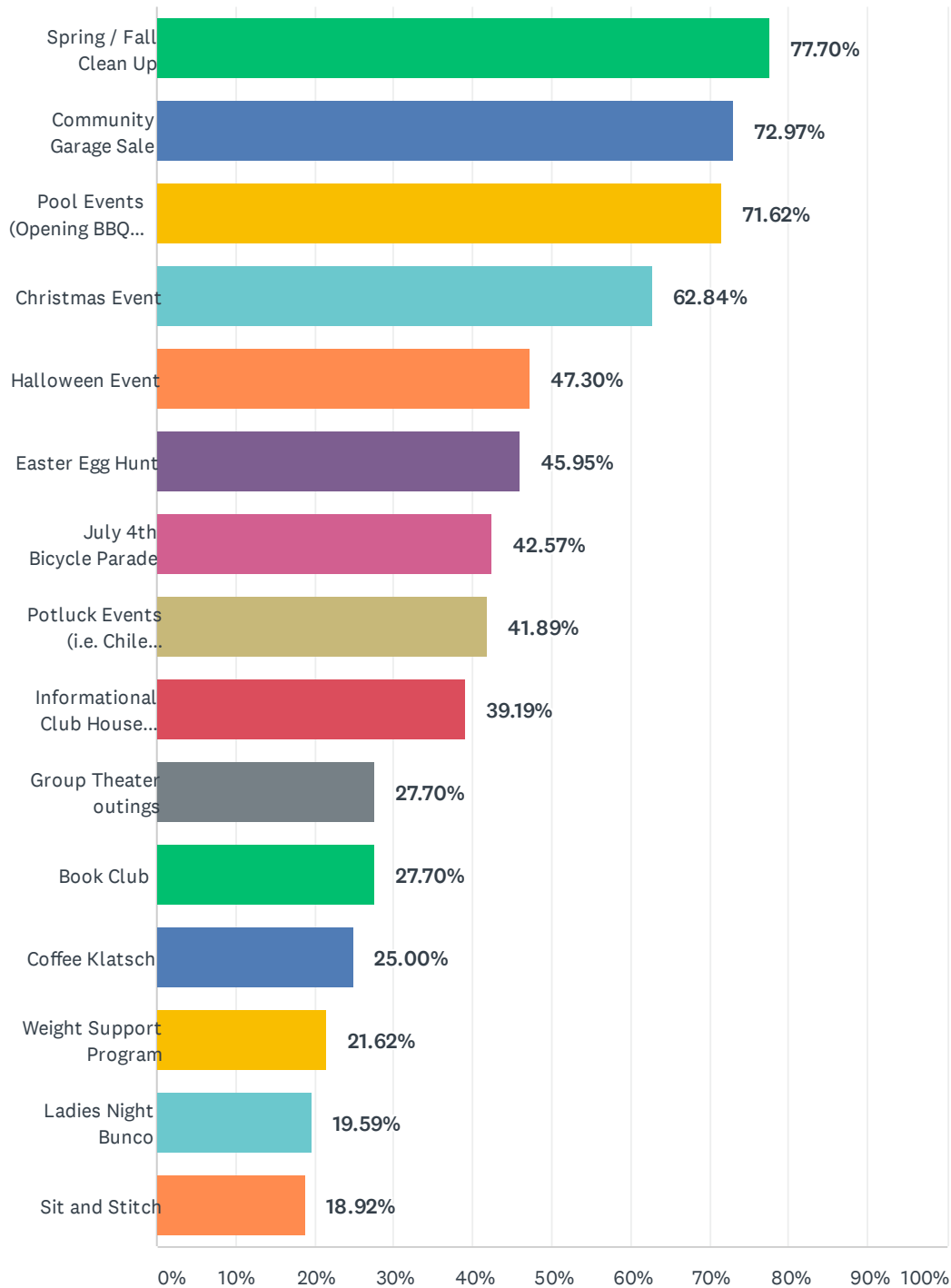

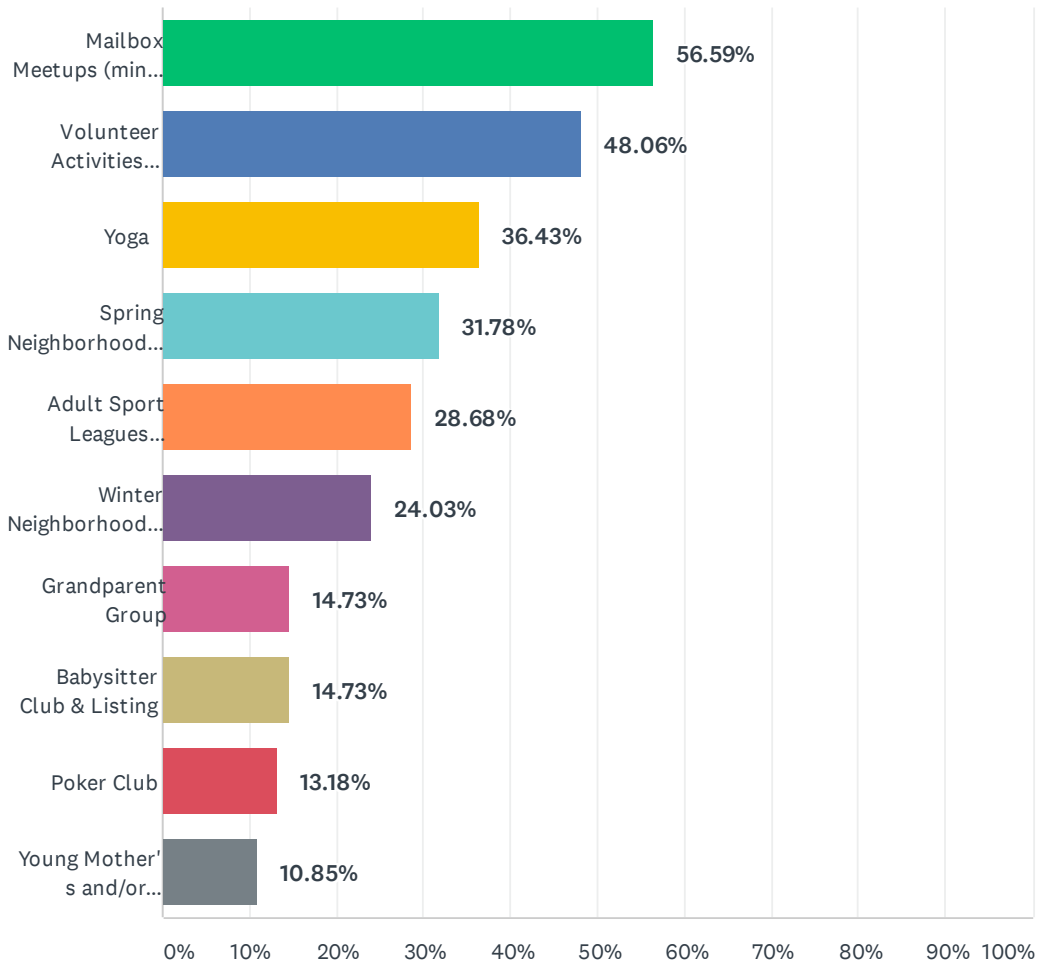
